Lt. Governor Francis: Supreme Court's Ruling Allows Territory to Continue Important Mission of Improving Healthcare

Lieutenant Governor Gregory R. Francis announced today that he is pleased with the Supreme Court's ruling on the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA). Francis is the territory's Commissioner of Insurance and Chairman of the territory's Healthcare Reform Implementation Task Force, which was established to implement the reforms stemming from the passage of the Act.

"I am pleased that the Supreme Court upheld the major components of the Affordable Care Act that are applicable to the territory," stated Francis.
